The Lebanese International University (LIU) was established in April 2001. Under Presidential Decree No. 5294 as "The Bekaa University", with its campus in Al Kilaia, the Bekaa. It graduated its first freshman class in June 2002. With a vision of becoming a true national university with an international presence, LIU established seven new campuses in Beirut, Saida, Nabatieh, Tripoli, Mount Lebanon, Tyre, Akkar and Aleppo, and the one was changed to Lebanese International University (LIU). In addition, international campuses now exist in Yemen, Mauritania and Senegal.

Important Information

Placement Exams
There are certain placement exams specific to each major which must be taken before admission. Please note that the scores of exams will not be disclosed, only the level of proficiency the student has achieved.

TOEFL
Any applicant will be exempted from the English placement exam if a score of 76 or above on the Internet Based TOEFL International (IBT) was achieved.

Freshman
Applicants to the Freshman Class must have the following:
 • Certified copy of the High School Diploma and report cards for grades 10, 11 and 12.
 • Passing SAT and SAT II scores, with a minimum combined score of 2400 for Freshman Arts, 2750 for Freshman Science. These must be completed before or during the freshman year.
 • A permission from the equivalence Committee of the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education, to pursue Higher education on the basis of a foreign (non-Lebanese) program.

Medical Coverage
Students will benefit from two kinds of medical coverage:
 • The National Social Security Fund (NSF). The mandatory service is designed to help them meet any financial difficulties arising from illness or accidents. During the first semester, LIU students will pay the yearly fee for NSF.
 • The health insurance of LIU students benefit from a medical insurance to cover emergencies. No additional fees will be required.

Financial Aid Policies & Procedures
Financial aid serves as means to achieve the educational mission of the Lebanese International University. It gives equal opportunities within budget constraints to all students, regardless of nationality, race, or religion. LIU offers a comprehensive program of student financial aid to ensure that no qualified student will be denied the opportunity for a university education because of a lack of family financial resources. The university reserves the right to change or withdraw any amount of aid granted.

SCHOOL OF Arts & Sciences

The programs offered by the School of Arts and Sciences of the Lebanese International University enable students to develop expertise in the major areas of: Fine Arts & Design, Communication Arts, Biological & Chemical, Physical, Computer, Nutrition & Food, and Biomedical Sciences. The school offers various programs of study at the undergraduate and graduate levels. The program of study are dynamic in order to keep pace with the rapidly evolving technology. The qualified and experienced school members are dedicated to providing theoretical as well as practical knowledge of high standard in a stimulating atmosphere. Students in this school are encouraged to explore a wide area of academic interests and to acquire varied research skills.

Program of Study
The School of Arts and Sciences offers the following different programs of study:

Undergraduate (Bachelor Degree)

- Biological & Chemical Sciences: Biology, Biochemistry
- Biomedical Sciences: Biomedical, Communication Arts: Radio and TV, Public Relations, Journalism, Advertising
- Computer Science and IT: Computer Science, Information Technology
- Fine Arts and Design: Graphic Design, Interior Design
- Nutrition & Food Sciences: Nutrition and Dietetics, Food Science and Technology
- Physical Sciences: Mathematics, Physics
- Graduate (Masters Degree): Mathematics, Computer Science, Food Technology

Admission Requirements
Applicants must pass the Lebanese Baccalaureate II (or its equivalent as specified by the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education). They are also required to sit for various placement tests (depending on the selected major). In addition to the University English Placement Test (EUPF) or the International TOEFL (with a score of 76 or above).

SCHOOL OF Pharmacy

The School of Pharmacy of the Lebanese International University aims to prepare pharmacists with high standard knowledge and practical experience in pharmacy practice that keeps up with the challenges and innovations encountered in the pharmacy profession. The first and second year broaden students' knowledge in basic biological, physical and chemical sciences and general education. The first, fourth and fifth years provide students with pharmaceutical education. Students will have the opportunity to practice drug dispensing and patients counseling in community and hospital pharmacies as well as in the University pharmacy dispensing lab. In the sixth year, students gain more experience in clinical drug application of different divisions of healthcare with well established, high standard hospital wards.

Admission Requirements
Bachelor of Pharmacy (BPharm)
Applicants must pass the Lebanese Baccalaureate II (General Sciences or Life Sciences) or its equivalent as specified by the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education. They are also required to sit for the University English Placement Test (EUPF) or the International TOEFL (with a score of 76 or above), in addition to the Biology Placement Test (BPT) and Chemistry Placement Test (CPT).

Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD)
LIU graduates must achieve a minimum GPA of 2.75 to be accepted in the PharmD program. They must also present three recommendations, both from instructors and from their careers. Candidates will be scheduled for an interview as part of the admission process with the Admission's Committee. Non-LIU students may apply for the PharmD program, yet they must take remedial courses and achieve a minimum GPA of 3. The following are the remedial courses: Pharmacology I and II, Pharmacotherapeutics I, II, III, IV and V, and Pharmacy Practice Experience II.
